**Bob Morrison**  
1938-2009

Bob Morrison never left home without a camera. He knew that today might bring the shot of a lifetime and he always wanted to be prepared to capture it if he could.

From athletic events to City festivals, Bob could often be seen capturing the spirit of The Little City with a still or video camera and encouraging others to do the same. Bob's extraordinary photographs are often showcased in art shows, schools, and businesses throughout the City.

All of us lost a great talent and good friend when Bob passed away in 2009. He was a selfless contributor of his time and talent to Falls Church City charities, an enduring friend of FCC-TV, and a long-term member of the Falls Church City Cable Access Corporation Board.

It is in his memory that the Board of Directors established the Bob Morrison Prize for Photography and Videography to encourage students to capture images of **Falls Church City - My Hometown.**

# How to Enter

In memory of longtime Cable Access Corporation Board member Bob Morrison, the Board will make four cash awards to Falls Church City students. Your entry should include five still photographs, or one video, capturing the theme **Falls Church City - My Hometown**. Photo and video winners in the 7 to 12 grade levels will receive \$200 each. Winners in grades K-6 will receive \$50 each. K-6 contestants are eligible to compete in the 7-12 grade levels for photography and video, but they are not eligible to win both divisions.

**Who is eligible:** Any student (grades K-12) who attends school in the City of Falls Church during the 2011-2012 school year.

**Theme:** Only appropriate photo and video content illustrating the theme of **Falls Church City - My Hometown** will be considered and accepted as an official entry.

**Criteria for an award:** A body of work (five photographs) or a video presentation that are recognizable as having been taken in the City of Falls Church and represent the hometown qualities of Falls Church City. This could include events, landmarks, people, nature and other visual opportunities that represent the best of Falls Church City and the artistic qualities that Bob Morrison captured in his photographs.

**Entry requirements:** Photographers must submit five, unframed images, no larger than 8 x 10 inches. Images may be submitted as prints or in digital format on CD, DVD or emailed to: palmrosem@fccps.org.

Please mark each submission with the student's name, home address, name of school, grade and phone number. All photographs and video presentations must be the work of the student submitting the entry. All submissions become the property of FCC-TV and may be used for station promotional purposes. Videographers must submit a single program or composite presentation that does not exceed 15 minutes. Longer single programs may be edited to 15 minutes representing the videographer's best segments. Video may be submitted on DVD or VHS tape. Video cases must be labeled with student's name, address, school name, grade and phone number. Each video must be the work of the student submitting the entry. All submissions become the property of FCC-TV and may be used for station promotional purposes. K-6 students may enter either category, or both, but they will be eligible to win only one category per contest year.

**Judging:** Entries will be judged by a three – judge panel on adherence to the theme, creativity, and technical competence. All participants will be recognized at the Falls Church Cable Access Corporation's annual meeting where the winners will be announced.

**Entry Deadline:** All entries must be received by 5:00 p.m. on Monday, April 23, 2012. No late entries will be accepted.
